## REQUEST FOR PUBLIC COMMENT

### 2016 Assessment of Fair Housing- Idaho's CDBG Non-Entitlement Areas (AFH)

The Idaho Department of Commerce (IDC) and Idaho Housing and Finance Association (IHFA) are the State Grantees for the following HUD-CPD programs: The Emergency Solutions Grant, HOME Investment Partnerships, Community Development Block Grant, and the Federal Housing Trust Fund. Grantees are required to conduct an analysis to identify impediments to fair housing choice within the CDBG non-entitlement areas of Idaho and take appropriate action to overcome the effects of any impediments identified through the analysis.

The 30-day comment period for the draft AFH is January 23, 2017 through February 22, 2017.
